This course is designed to review topics covered on the ATI LPN Predictor Test which is used as the nursing entrance exam at The Helene Fuld College of Nursing

This course covers nursing contents from the practical nursing program experience. The fundamental skills necessary to meet the physiological and psychosocial needs of instable clients will be reviewed. Nursing care during the antepartal, intrapartal, postpartal, and neonatal periods will be discussed. This course will also include instruction in the areas of health alterations, the nursing process, client needs and clinical practice. Test-taking skills will be addressed in all courses. Classes are small to facilitate individualized instruction.

Spring 2012 dates: Tuesdays, May 8 - June 12, 2012, 9 am - 12 pm.

The course runs for six weeks. The tuition is \$400.
