

**Preparation Courses in Reading, Writing, Math and Nursing Topics**

**Reading:** This course covers reading comprehension (to the 12<sup>th</sup> grade level) & test taking skills. This course will prepare applicants for the entrance exam in reading, as well as teach various decoding skills.

**Writing:** This course will cover the following concepts: grammar review, paragraph construction, essay format & development, how to generate arguments, and support of ideas in basic compositions. This course will prepare applicants for college-level writing

**Math:** This course will cover mathematical concepts up to and including 9<sup>th</sup> grade math, specifically: arithmetic, algebra, geometry, measurements and conversions, interpretation of data, tables and graphs, and percentages.

**Nursing:** This course will cover nursing contents from the practical nursing program experience. The fundamental skills necessary to meet the physiological and psychosocial needs of instable clients will be reviewed. Nursing care during the antepartal, intrapartal, postpartal, and neonatal periods will be discussed. This course will also include instruction in the areas of health alterations, the nursing process, client needs and clinical practice.

**Test-taking skills will be addressed in all courses. Classes are small to facilitate individualized instruction.**

**Courses run for six weeks.**

The tuition for one course is \$400.

All materials are provided, including customized instructor made materials and official ATI practice exams and materials.
